The Chasing M2 Pro and Pro Max have eight thrusters, allowing movement in any direction, and can carry out high-definition recording with a 4K lens.

They have a removable 300Wh standard battery for longer endurance, which can be upgraded to a 700Wh battery, and have the capacity for mounting multiple accessories.

The Chasing M2 Pro and Pro Max also have high-powered motors with anti-flow capability, a built-in docking station (M2 Pro Max) and external floodlights for greater image clarity.

Optional accessories include a grabber arm, E-reel, camera, DLS and equipment for water sampling and monitoring.
